Register for the SAT I or ACT and if required by any of your schools the SAT II (Subject Tests).
• Register for the SAT directly at www.collegeboard.org
• Register for the ACT directly at www.ACTstudent.org
• Be sure to request that your official scores be sent directly from the testing agency to the college or university. **FOUR** free reports can be sent to colleges of your choice when you sign up. **CHS will not send your SAT or ACT scores.**

Request Letters of Recommendation from current teachers, counselors, administration
• Try to request letters from those individuals that know you best and who may teach in the subject area you wish to pursue in college (Be sure to request in Naviance)
• Most colleges require 1-2 recommendation letters from teachers
• *Request for Letter of Recommendation Forms* must be submitted to teachers or counselors to request letters. These forms are available in the School Counseling Office

Register with the NCAA Clearinghouse
• You should register during junior year at www.ncaa.org ONLY if you’re planning on playing a D1 or D2 sport in college
