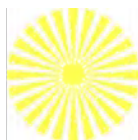
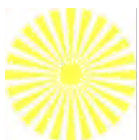

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## OVERVIEW OF SUMMER ENRICHMENT

Once again Coventry Public Schools will be offering summer enrichment programs that inspire and nurture our Coventry students. Our selection of Summer Enrichment programs provide rewarding and fun filled opportunities for students of all ages. This brochure contains details for each camp.

Summer Enrichment programming is self-supporting and is designed and facilitated by staff. There is no cost to the Board of Education as program tuition covers the costs of teacher salaries and supplies. Program fees will not be collected at the time of registration. Once classes are confirmed, families will be notified and fees will be collected. Sessions may be cancelled if there is low enrollment.

Financial assistance may be available for any of the enrichment programs, so please let us know if you require any assistance.

Transportation is the responsibility of the student or parent/guardian. Please be prompt when picking up students.

Student behavioral expectations are the same as during the regular school year. All school rules apply.

## THIRD GRADE SUMMER ACADEMY

The third grade academy provides 3 engaging days of summer learning activities for incoming third grade students. The academy is centered on small group instruction that equips upcoming third graders to feel more prepared for the 2022-2023 school year. The curriculum is tailored to each student, based on recommendations from second grade teachers. Each student will receive personalized lessons in reading, writing, and math, specific to their needs. Technology will be used to support student learning and success. The goal of the third grade summer academy is to produce confident students who are well prepared for a successful transition into third grade. The academy also provides a great opportunity to relieve anxiety for students who may be worried about going to a new school.

## BAND CAMPS

The purpose of band camps is to give interested students an opportunity to participate in a band program during the summer. **Intermediate Band:** All wind and percussion instruments welcome. This group is intended for students who already have experience playing their instruments. Join us for a week of working on both classical and contemporary concert band music, as well as pep band tunes! This camp will culminate in an informal concert on Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup> at 11:30 a.m. in the band room.

**Jazz Band:** This group is intended for students who already have experience playing their instruments. All instruments welcome. Join us for a fun week of jazz! Students will study a variety of jazz styles and work on improvisation skills.

## LEGO CODING

The LEGO Education WeDo 2.0 program is a hands-on science program for elementary students. It develops science practices in the classroom through a robot-based learning system. Students will be able to create and explore scientific discoveries as they build, program, and modify projects. As students experiment and investigate, they will deeply engage with science, engineering, technology, and coding. Please note that this camp is limited to 8 students. Names will be selected based on lottery.

## SCIENCE OLYMPIAD

The Science Olympiad Summer Camp is an excellent opportunity for students to experience what it is like to compete in a Science Olympiad Tournament. Students will participate in two or three Science Olympiad events. The camp events are the same as those used in the Connecticut State and National Tournaments. At the end of the 2 week camp, students will participate in our camp competition which will be modeled after actual Science Olympiad competitions. Instructor is the Division B State Tournament Director, former coach of top-placing Irving A Robbins MS team and current coach of last year's new Captain Nathan Hale team.

## SUMMER HYDROPONICS

Join us for three weeks of hydroponics growing in the “living laboratory” at Coventry High School. You will learn the basics of growing in a hydroponic system, including plant nutrition, system maintenance, and food safety. We will also touch upon aquaponics growing techniques. You will learn how hydroponics can be used to address global food needs in an environmentally beneficial manner. Students will work in the geodesic greenhouse each day and have an active role in maintaining the hydroponics system there during the early part of the summer. Participants of this course will be well equipped with the knowledge necessary to start their own miniature system.
